October 3rd & 4th: St. Francis animal blessing – bring a favorite toy animal to school.

October 10th: Columbus Day – **PRE-K NOT IN SESSION**

October 13th: Last day to return Pre-K fundraiser and shirt orders. Please send your fundraiser in as soon as possible. **We cannot accept orders after this date as we send them out immediately.**

October 24th & October 25th: Halloween Festival – sign-up sheets will be posted outside of your child's classroom the first week of October for volunteers who would like to help at the festival. Children should **not wear** their costumes the day of the festival.

October 27th & October 28th: Halloween Parade – Please let your child wear his/her Halloween costume to school to participate in our Halloween Parade. The parade will be held at 9:15 a.m. The children will walk around the playground if the weather permits. In case of inclement weather, the parade will be held in the cafeteria.

October 28th: Trunk or Treat – 6:00 pm to 8:30 pm. In case of inclement weather, the rain date will be Sunday, October 30th from 3:30 pm to 7:30 pm. Please check your PreschoolICExpress for more information.

Please make sure your child's costume is safe to wear to school. If it has a mask, please make sure your child can see through it. We do not allow play swords, knives or guns in school.

Please send back your signed photo/video/local media minor release form which will be on the express shortly.

Congratulations to all the children who have been coming into school by themselves. They have been doing a great job. Please encourage your child to leave you at the door.

Please Note: Unless you have notified Mrs. Saracino (at rsaracino@icspotswood.com) requesting an alternate tuition date, all tuitions are due the first day your child attends school in October. There is a \$15.00 late fee for tuitions paid after the first week. If your account is up to date, this is your third tuition payment.

If you have not sent in your child's medical, please send it in immediately. Your child's medical must be on file for your child to continue Pre-K.

Please give us a call when your child is not going to attend school. We need to know if your child is sick with fever, cough, strep throat, etc. to keep our records accurate.
